2. Be enrolled at a university of teacher-training institution in a course leading to a degree or certificate in music education.
3. Have successfully completed at least one (1) year of said course.
4. Enclose or forward a transcript of marks from both your high school and university.
5. Have this application to the scholarship chair by May 15. (See address below)
6. Enclose a short essay with your views on music education and your plans regarding participation in the field following completion of courses.
